Well within the financial reach of most organ buyers, the Leslie Model 125 offers "sound in motion" with an ingenious blending of an independent amplifier, high quality speaker and compact enclosure. The 125 has a very strong bass which adds a stirring realism to the organ and full brilliant middle ranges and treble sounds. The cabinet is intentionally neutral in design, blending into the decor so the sound seems to fill every corner of the room. With its physical separation from the organ console speaker, the Model 125 adds a stereophonic effect to the music and makes it possible to create a "duet" between the two sound sources. The rotor may be operated at two different speeds. In the "fast" position, a lush tibia is created. At "slow" speed, the rotor produces the ethereal and undulating effect of the famous chorale.
