The Model 145 is one of the most popular Leslie speakers ever built. It combines the double rotor system and two-speed performance in a moderately priced system that produces a full-range tremolo sound famous around the world. The physical separation of the speaker cabinet from the organ console speaker creates a unique stereophonic effect—a duet of music in motion. To further enhance the sound a cross-over network separates the high frequency sounds from the lows. The highs are channeled to a 2-speed spinning horn rotor and the lows are directed to a 2-speed bass rotor. This separates and enriches the musical effect. By varying the rotor speeds, two different types of sound can be produced. In fast position the Leslie speaker produces an exciting tremolo. Contrasting with the vibrant tremolo, the slower chorale creates an undulating, ethereal sound... a "cathedral" sound. The cabinet design is intentionally neutral, blending into the room decor... surrounding the listener with the sound accepted by musicians everywhere as the standard of excellence.
